

## Learning the Alphabet With Songs

Many children learn the letter names before the shapes of the letters by singing the alphabet. When children know how to say the alphabet before they learn the names for each symbol, they can anchor the name to the visual representation of the letter.

Sing the alphabet song to other common tunes to help students realize that LMNOP are five separate letters. These song charts can be enlarged for whole group use. The song charts show the letters arranged as they will be sung to match the tunes.

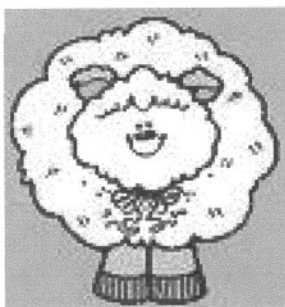
