



Student Assignments During the eLearning Weather Day

In grades K-2, teachers will provide hardcopy work to take home that may require some adult assistance.

In grades 3-12, teachers will post their eLearning assignments on Schoology by the end of the school day today. Students will then make their assignments available offline before leaving school. Teachers should assist with this, or resources can be found [HERE](#).

Assignment Workloads

Students' work will provide meaningful learning activities related to their current units of study that require no more than 30 minutes per subject area in grades K-5 and 20 minutes per subject area in grades 6-12. Assignments will be provided for the following subjects:

- Grades K-2: reading, math, and physical education (PE)
- Grades 3-5: all core subjects and PE
- Grades 6-7: all core subjects, PE, and STEM
- Grades 8-12: all subjects for 7 periods

Assignment Due Dates

As students complete their work, they should upload their assignments via Schoology if Wi-Fi is available. If an Internet connection is unavailable, they must submit assigned digital work immediately when they return to school.

Attendance and Grading

All students will initially be counted as present on the eLearning Days. However, if the assigned work is not completed by the return date, the student must be coded as absent on the days that school was canceled. Since their assignments are just like any others, failure to do their work will be graded in accordance with the teacher's grading policy.
