Word of the Week—Responsibility

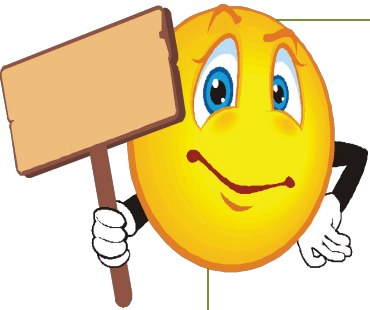
Meaning: *The condition of being responsible. Obligated to carry out or take care of, as duty, trust or debt. Reliable. Caring for something, or to be in charge of something.*

Respectfulness

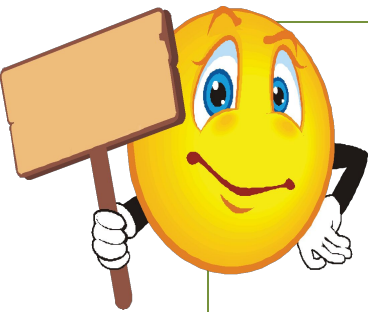
Meaning: *To have or show high regard for. The state of being esteemed. To treat with courtesy or consideration.*

Meaning: *The quality of being dependable, reliable, worthy of trust. Fulfilling what one consented to do, even if it meant unexpected sacrifices.*

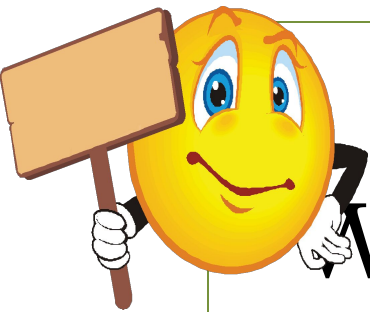
Monday Define word of the day
